Parents and Students:

The ACT (American College Testing) and The College Board (SAT & PSAT) offer fee waivers to reduce the cost of the ACT, SAT, and PSAT exams for students from families who qualify under the criteria listed below. Qualifying students should speak with their school counselor about fee waivers for these examinations.

The College Board also offers a reduced fee exam for students taking the Advanced Placement (AP) exams each May. The criteria for the reduced exam fee are the same as the criteria for testing fee waivers (listed below). Qualifying students who plan to take AP exams should speak with their school's AP Testing Coordinator to ensure they are listed on the schools' records as qualifying for the exam at a reduced fee.

If students have used a SAT test fee waiver prior to the '23-24 school year, additional fee waivers can be found on the student's SAT College Board account. A maximum of (2) SAT and (4) ACT waivers. Waivers may be obtained during a student's 11th and 12th grade year.
