Some exceptions include:

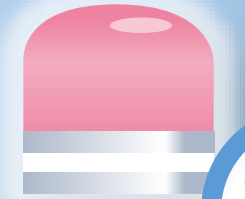
- imminent danger to self or others suspicion of

If you see/hear something suspicious, report it to an adult.

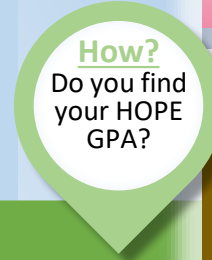

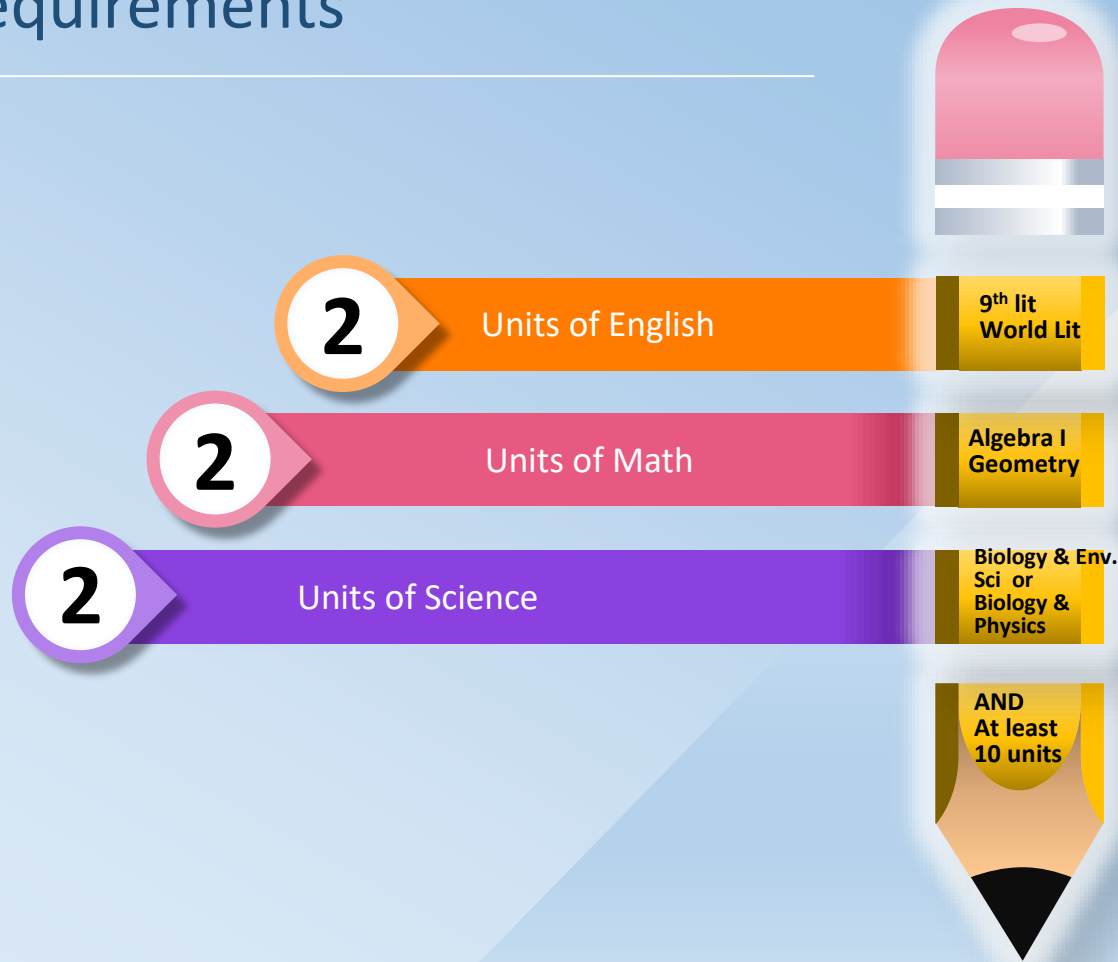


Graduation Requirements

Subject Area	# of Credits Needed
English	4
Math	4
Science	4
Social Studies	3
Health/Personal Fitness	1 (0.5 Health/0.5 BPE)
Career Tech and/or Fine Arts and/or World Language (WL)* (any combination will do)	3 *2 credits of the <u>same</u> WL are required for college entrance
Electives	4
Total	23

Promotion Requirements

Students can earn up to 8 credits/units per year. To be promoted to the 11th grade you must earn a total of 10 credits.



Transcripts- two types



CCSD

**Cobb County
Transcript**

Personal Information, Cumulative weighted and unweighted GPA, credits earned and attempted, EOC scores. Attendance info- when you entered high school.

HOPE

HOPE Transcript

Lists your all courses but only HOPE eligible courses are used to calculate your HOPE GPA. You can also see courses that count towards rigor requirement.

What is a GPA?

Cumulative Grade Point Average=

The average of **ALL** grades earned in high school. (**PASSED or FAILED**)

Includes Electives (PE, CTAE, Fine Arts, etc.)

Letter Grade	On-Level	Honors= 0.5 Extra Quality Points	AP= 1.0 Extra Quality Points
A	4.0	4.5	5.0
B	3.0	3.5	4.0
C	2.0	2.5	3.0
D	1.0	1.5	2.0
F	0.0	0.0	0.0

Dual Enrollment (DE)

DE is a state funded program that allows 11th and 12th graders to take college classes while completing their high school diploma.

DE also provides limited options for 10th graders

DE pays for 100% tuition, mandatory fees, and required textbooks up to a maximum cap of 30 hours (*this equates to roughly one year of full-time college enrollment or around 10 courses*)

Any 10th grader can take CTAE classes at a Technical College

10th graders who have earned a 1200 SAT or 26 ACT (in one sitting) are eligible to apply to any DE program

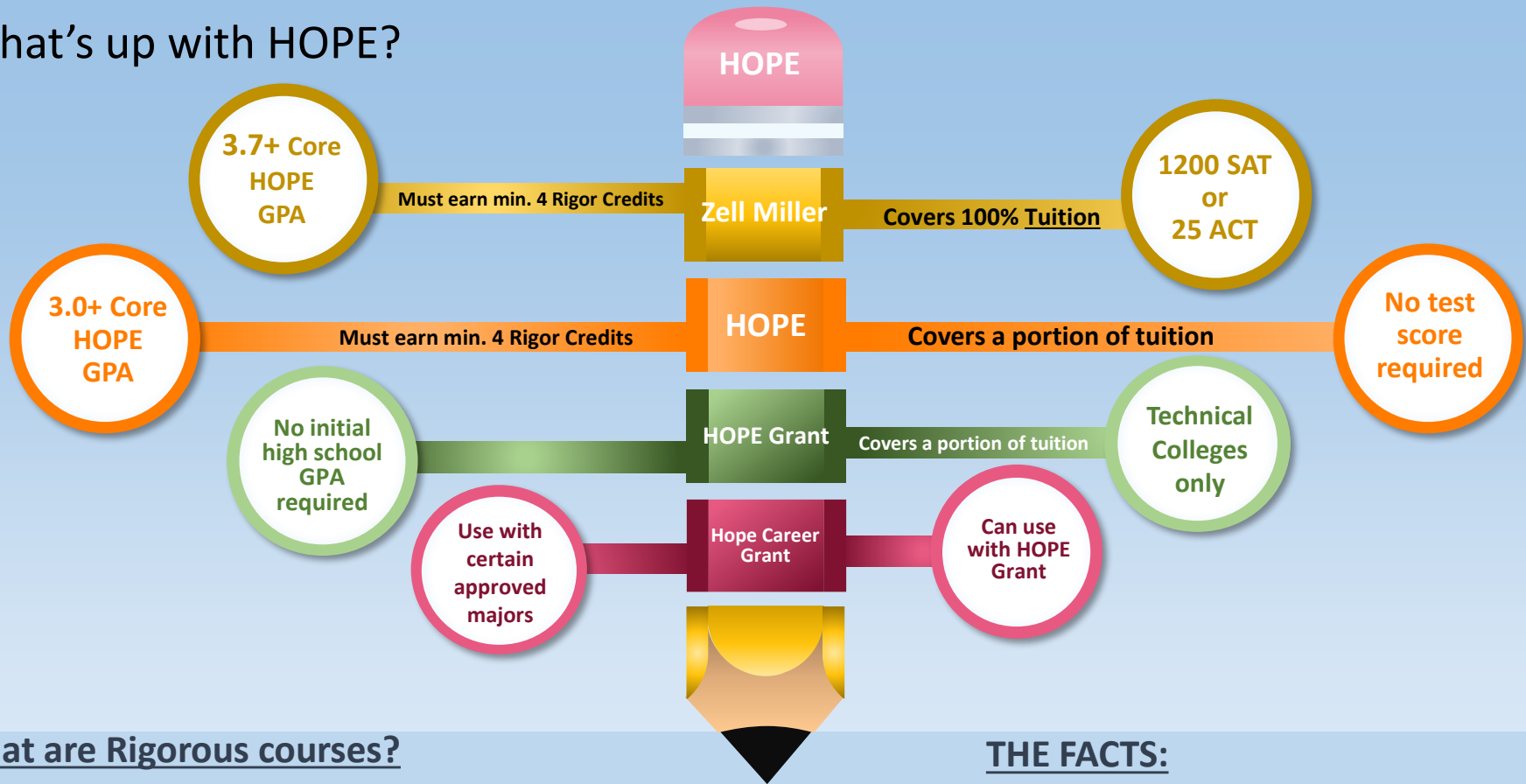

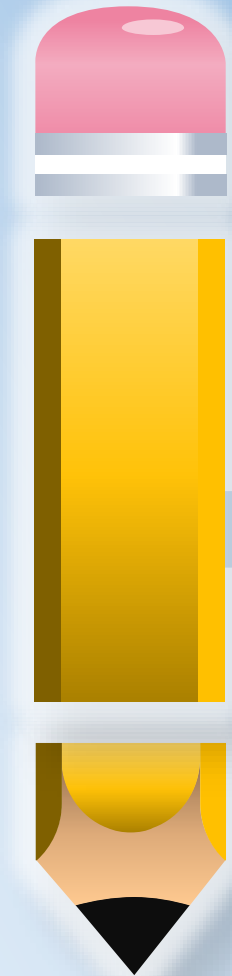


What are Rigorous courses?

- Advanced Math: Alg. 2, Pre-Calculus, Statistics
- Advanced Science: Chemistry, Physics, Anatomy
- Advanced Placement: Any core AP courses
- University System of Georgia: DE courses in core subjects
- Advanced Modern Language: Level 2 and higher

THE FACTS:

- ➔ Must graduate from a GA High School.
- ➔ Must be a GA resident for at least one year.
- ➔ Student's SSN must be updated in CCSD records to receive HOPE funds. No SSN = NO HOPE!
